COMMENTS

As much as I tried to find a nice, juicy longshot to kick off the day, after watching INTERACTIF's effort in the Bourbon at Keeneland on Oct. 11, I just couldn't look past the son of Broken Vow. The Todd Pletcher trainee advanced extremely wide on the far turn, yet still managed to win with ridiculous ease. POUNCED seems to be getting all the "buzz," but I'm slightly concerned about the stretch-out, particularly after he faded in the seven-furlong Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere. True, that was a Group 1 affair, but bettors will pay for that fact with a deflated price. KERA'S KITTEN had a dream trip in his latest, but made the most of it by earning a 75 Beyer and a -1 late speed ration (LSR). Still, trainer Mike Maker intimated he thinks DEAN'S KITTEN may be the better of the two. And, if you're looking for a live longshot, take a peek at SUMMER MOVIE, who earned a 74 Beyer and race-best 0 LSR in breaking his maiden over today's Arcadia turf course.

COMMENTS

In a race filled with lousy-looking contenders — I guess that's to be expected after DESERT CODE's stunning victory last year — it's hard not to be impressed by GOTTA HAVE HER and dumbfounded by her 15-1 morning line. Sure, she's a mare running against the boys, but the daughter of Royal Academy is a perfect 4-of-4 at today's distance and earned a career-best 101 Beyer figure and -4 LSR in her latest outing. DIAMONDRELLA, another mare, ironically, also rates strong consideration in this spot, as she drops from a winning effort in the Grade I First Lady over Tizaqueena and Forever Together. CALIFORNIA FLAG has dangerous early speed. The others can be used at a price.

COMMENTS

In a highly contentious race, I'll look for a price with DANCING IN SILKS and CAPT. CANDY MAN. The former has earned competitive speed and pace figures (and is 12-1 on the morning line), while the latter is one of the best three-year-old sprinters in America. Obviously, FATAL BULLET, GAYEGO and ZENSATIONAL are strong contenders as well, but the odds figure to be light.

COMMENTS

Grab a ouija board, Magic 8-Ball, along with a set of darts, because this contest is a real guessing game. Again, when in doubt, I look for a price. NOBLE'S PROMISE and ESKENDEREYA have the best LSRs in the field, which is especially impressive in the case of the latter, who recorded her figure on dirt, so they're logical contenders at the right odds. BEETHOVEN also rates a long look, as he reminds me a bit of Wilko, winner of the 2004 Juvenile.

COMMENTS

ZACINTO is young (three years old) and improving. Plus, he fits the profile of a Mile winner to a "T." BC Mile entrants that raced at a distance other than eight furlongs in their final prep are zip for 20 since 2003, a stat that GOLDIKOVA hopes to change as she exits the seven-furlong Prix de la Foret at Longchamp, where she faded to third in the last 100 yards. COWBOY CAL and FERNLEY don't look as strong as the Euros, but may offer value.

This is another race best handicapped with a deck of Tarot cards. FURTHEST LAND is unbeaten over a synthetic surface and posted a 106 Beyer and race-best +1 LSR in his latest, a hard-fought neck victory over Dubious Miss in the Grade 2 Kentucky Cup Classic. Sure NEKO BAY enters the Dirt Mile off of a win in an ordinary allowance race, but look who he beat — Mast Track, a former Grade 1 winner. Plus, he's proven at this distance and goes for a conditioner, John Shirreffs, who knows how to win on Santa Anita's faux dirt terrain. The others can be used at or above their fair odds.

PRESIOUS PASSION owns the best last-race LSR and figures to control the pace, making him dangerous in a race that most bettors will undoubtedly grant to the Europeans. Last year's champ CONDUIT and SPANISH MOON are clearly the ones to beat — just a matter of price.

COMMENTS

There are very few instances in horseracing when one knows that a given horse will be an underlay, but that is certainly the case with the great mare ZENYATTA, who makes her bow against the boys in the Breeders' Cup Classic. At her home track, with an unbeaten record on the line, Zenyatta is sure to receive more attention than a guy dressed in jeans and a T-shirt at a Star Trek convention. Thus, she's an automatic toss-out for me — and the same goes for SUMMER BIRD, who is trying Santa Anita's Pro-Ride surface for the first time, yet is a lowly 9-2 on the morning line. RIP VAN WINKLE? He's a great horse, but he's been having hoof problems (remember Big Brown?).

Hence, I'll be looking for pari-mutuel love from QUALITY ROAD, COLONEL JOHN and TWICE OVER. Frankly, I still believe the former is one of the best racehorses in the country — bar none,

while COLONEL JOHN has earned nearly a million dollars racing on "fake" dirt. As for TWICE OVER, although he appeared to tire a bit in the Champion Stakes last time, he still won that Group 1 affair and should get a stamina boost from the effort.

Win Factor Report

November 7, 2009

CATEGORIES

RACE RATING: A percentage (0-100) preceding the race number that measures the separation between contenders and the inherent value (overlay) potential of the race in question. Higher percentages generally indicate more predictable and/or formful races.

WIN FACTOR: A comprehensive rating (ranging from 0 to 10) comprised of general ability, current form, speed, class, conditioning, and distance compatibility. The higher the rating, the more reliable the Fair Odds are likely to be. Horses that are switching surfaces or those coming off of long layoffs are designated as "unknowns" (UK). Ratings preceded by a dollar sign (\$) denote a Key Selection.

RECENT PLACING: Horse's placing in his/her most recent start: (W)in, (P)lace, or (S)how. A plus notation (+) indicates a performance at today's par or above, while an exclamation point (!) represents a significant recent speed advantage over today's foes.

CLASS PAR: A comparison between today's par and the par of the horse's latest race. A "⊖" symbol indicates a horse moving down in par, a "⊕" character denotes a horse moving up, and a "⊙" icon signifies no change.

TRACK & DAYS LAPSED: The racetrack at which the horse most recently competed and the number of days since that effort.

WIN RATE: Horse's current winning percentage.

CLASS RATING: A figure (ranging from 0 to 1) that measures both average earnings per start and average purse value as a means of identifying overall class. Anything above 0.25 is considered to be significant and is highlighted by bold type in the report.

RATED STARTS: The number of races used to derive the performance ratings listed above. Horses with less than five Rated Starts should be treated with great caution and their performance numbers greeted with skepticism (see below).

FAIR ODDS: The minimum acceptable betting odds on the contender(s) in question. Fair odds are independent of track take and are adjusted for unknown entities. Odds preceded by a "@" sign indicate a Prime Overlay possibility. Those followed by a "U" denote a potential underlay.

GUIDELINES

The purpose of this report is really twofold. Obviously, the primary goal is to increase your profits at the track by providing a reliable odds line. Beyond that, however, you will also find a lot of other useful and unique data that can be incorporated into your own handicapping. Regardless of how you choose to view the data provided, some general observations are in order:

- ◆ All ratings and selections (unless otherwise noted) are made in light of the conditions existing at the time of entry. Races taken off the turf, or modified in any way, should be passed.
- ◆ Because the goal is to provide as accurate an odds line as possible, not all horses are rated. This is due to the fact that not every horse can be reasonably assessed given the criteria that is used. If the other data provided, or your own analysis suggests that such a horse is a contender, then by all means consider him/her. While an attempt is made to adjust the Fair Odds in accordance with the overall ability level of any unknown entrants, it is probably wise to pass races with an excessive number of unrated competitors.
- ◆ Be very wary of horses with fewer than five Rated Starts. Because their performance ratings are based on such limited data, they tend to be notoriously unreliable — even when they appear to be overlays.
- ◆ Prime Overlay possibilities produce tremendous profits when played at or above their Fair Odds, while Key Selections are strong contenders (at any price) that can be used to anchor your exotic wagering. Underlays should generally be avoided. In the event of scratches, players can (and should) adjust the fair odds.
- ◆ When wagering on overlays, bet to Win only. Betting longshots to Place or Show in a pari-mutual system is a sure way to the poorhouse. That being said, ALWAYS check the pools. Occasionally, a horse will be severely underbet or a favorite radically overbet in one or more of the other betting pools.

◆ If a horse with a low or non-existent Win Factor rating is going to post as a heavy favorite or you observe other severe discrepancies in the Win Factor ratings and the tote, it is best to limit your wagering. When none of the top plays are getting any action, it is likely that the Fair Odds are out of sync or irrelevant in that event.

◆ No distinction is made between restricted and unrestricted races in regards to performance standards such as wins and earnings; thus, ratings can occasionally be unjustly skewed towards females or horses that have raced exclusively in state-bred company.

◆ Try to be conscious of anything that greatly alters the composition of a race (extreme biases, excessive scratches, etc.). Exercise good wagering judgment at all times!

◆ Only bet what you can afford to lose. Never attempt to "get even" after a loss or use race wagering as your own personal ATM machine. Such strategies will only lead to disaster — regardless of the skill you bring to the game.
